Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens up to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. It has great length and is rounded and supple on the finish

<b>Domaine Barons de Rothschild Brut</b>		80
Pale gold glints mingling with very fine bubbles which produce abundant, persistent frothiness. This cuvee gives off aromas of pear, almonds and fresh hazelnuts which mingle with notes of white flowers and light accents of brioche.

<b>Dom Perignon Cuvée</b>		195
A wonderfully complex aroma, with scents of white flowers, citrus and stone fruit enhanced by the freshness of aniseed and crushed mint. Finally, spicy, woody and roasted notes emerge. Perfectly balanced with the nose, the palate is streamlined and pure, with an underlying warmth. Clear, pronounced fruit and a well-integrated acidity, lead to an aromatic and smoky finish

<b>Pol Roger Sir Winston Churchill</b>		195
Deep golden-yellow colour with a continuous thread of lingering bubbles. The elegant nose delivers intense and complex aromas, dominated by enticing notes of dried fruit, toasted almond and honey. On the palate the wine is full bodied, boasting a powerful, rich structure, yet balanced with a refreshing acidity and flavourful notes of citrus fruit

<b>Rully Blanc Louis Latour</b> Beautiful pale yellow colour. Broiled and smoked notes with subtle hints of almond, vanilla and mango. Ample and fresh, underlines aromas of yellow fruits and almond Region of origin: France ABV: 13%			35

<b>Copia Zinfandel</b> Bursting with strawberry fruit flavours and a smooth creaminess on the palate producing a mouth-watering off dry sweetness Region of origin: Italy ABV: 11.5%	3.3	6.3	18

<b>Petite Fleur Cabernet Sauvignon</b> The nose is dominated by black fruits and spicy notes. On the palate, there are abundant flavours of elderberry, bramble, cinnamon and orange zest with soft, round tannins providing a silky finish Region of origin: France ABV: 13%	3.1	6	17
<b>Trivento Tribu Malbec</b> Vibrant violet in colour, this unoaked wine shows the pure fruit characteristics of the Malbec grape. With red berries and herbs on the nose, it possesses a medium body and soft rounded tannins Region of origin: Argentina ABV: 13%	3.3	6.3	18
<b>Blass Reserve Shiraz</b> A medium-bodied, easy-drinking, wine with plenty of juicy, red berry, flavours, and a smooth, rounded palate Region of origin: Australia ABV: 13.5%	3.3	6.3	18
<b>Vista Sierra Malbec</b> Fresh easy-drinking Malbec from high altitude vineyards in Mendoza. Bright forest fruits and plum flavours with a smooth finish of black plum with hints of milk chocolate. <b>La Crema Pinot Noir</b> Extended time on the vine creates an unrestrained flavour profile of bright rich flavours Region of origin: USA ABV: 13.5%			36
<b>Cuvee De L'Hospice Châteauneuf du Pape Rouge</b> An expressive bouquet of red fruits on the nose. Ample palate with a great structure and generous, complex characteristics of this famous appellation Region of origin: Rhone Valley ABV: 14%			37.5
<b>Torre Del Falasco Cantina Valpantena Amarone Della Valpolicella</b> Strong, rich and vigorous, yet surprising in its balance, maturity and refinement; a perfect blend of strength and elegance Region of origin: Italy ABV: 15%			38
<b>Brigaldara Amarone</b> Bright red, clean red cherry and berry aromas are lifted by a floral touch. Sweet on entry with a nice glyceric mouthfeel, then somewhat bitter with noteworthy tannic bite to the lively red berry flavours. Finishes classically dry and with a trace of alcohol-derived heat Region of origin: Italy ABV: 16.5%			48
<b>Gaja Brunello di Montalcino</b> Bouquet of wildflowers and red berries, followed by fresh balsamic notes, notably sweet liquorice and thyme. The palate is very clean with flavours of fresh plum and red cherry, well integrated wood aromas and silky tannins Region of origin: Italy ABV: 15%			99.5
